

## CLEARWATER FRESHMAN VOLLEYBALL TOURNAMENT

DATE: Saturday, September 26, 2020 8:00 a.m.

LOCATION: Clearwater High School – 1201 E Ross, Clearwater, 67026

ADMISSION: Adults \$6.00 Students \$4.00 No passes accepted.

The visiting team will receive TWENTY-FIVE (25) wristbands. Spectators must wear the event specific wristband on wrist in order to purchase tickets at the event and enter the gymnasium.

CONCESSIONS: We will have a small concession stand in the Commons Area.

MATCHES: All matches will be best 2 out of 3 games. The first two games will be played to 25 with no cap. If a 3<sup>rd</sup> game is necessary, it will be played to 15 points (win by 2).

BRACKET: The format for the freshman tournament will be two pools of 4 teams each. The top two teams from each pool will advance to the championship round.
