

- All games played at the home court of the higher seed. Example: #1 vs. #4 #1 seed will host. Sub-State seeding will take place on Wednesday, February 24 at 10:00 AM.
- Attendance Guidelines Each school will follow 25% capacity guidelines, per county guidance. Each participant will receive at least four (4) spectators. Spectators must be on the list provided by each school. Each school will receive equal number of spectators.
- Fans are not permitted into facility until 45 minutes before game.
- No fans allowed on court, teams are to leave court after game and go to locker rooms, dress and proceed to busses.
- Due to social distancing requirements student sections will not be permitted.
- Teams allowed on site 1 hour before game time.
- Balls on court 40 minutes before game time.
- Bench limits teams cannot bring any extras. 12 players, head coach, 2 assistants, 2 managers, and athletic trainer.
- February 27th game time will be determined at the time of the seeding meeting.
- March 2nd, 3rd, and 5th games will be played at 7:00 PM.
- March 6th game will be played at 3:00 PM.
- Cheerleaders will be allowed to participate limited to eight (8) on the end line, six-feet apart.
- Host school band will be allowed to perform and are included in the capacity total.
- All games will be broadcast on the NFHS Network. Subscription will be required to view games.
- Play-in games (both boys and girls) will be played on Saturday, February 27th.
- Sub-State boys games will be played on Tuesday, March 2nd, and Friday, March 5th.
- Sub-State girls games will be played on Wednesday, March 3rd, and Saturday, March 6th.
